

The Town of Truckee (TOT) has awarded the Glenshire Drive/Dorchester Drive Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements Project to Granite Construction. The projected date to commence construction is July 24, 2017. The project is scheduled to take approximately (10) weeks to complete. Working hours will generally be Monday through Friday 7AM – 5PM.

The project will involve; *safety improvements, drainage improvements, utility adjustments, removal and replacement of existing roadway, Class 2 bike lanes on both sides of Glenshire and Dorchester Drive, a new left turn lane on Glenshire Dr. at the Dorchester Dr. intersection, a new trail connection between Berkshire Circle and the Legacy Trail, residential driveway improvements, striping, and signage throughout the project limits.*

During construction, a minimum of 11' one way paved lane will be open in each direction with flagger control. Short traffic delays may occur during removal, utility, and roadway operations. If possible, we recommend you consider alternate routes to and from residential properties. Access will be maintained to residential properties for the duration of the project; however, temporary driveway closures up to one hour or more may occur during utility removal and replacement at certain driveways. Granite Construction will notify you 18-24 hours in advance of driveway closures. For safety reasons, parking on the street will not be possible within the construction traffic control zones during construction.
