



COMPLETED 2/16/23 to 4/4/23: Board Review – During this time four public meetings were held where the Board reviewed committee recommendations, made changes to the proposed Governing Documents and approved a final draft of the documents to move forward for member review and comment.

4/27/23 to 6/7/23: Member Review & Input Period – Documents will be distributed electronically and posted on the GDRA website for member review on 4/27/23. This will open a member comment period. Any and all comments may be sent by completing the [member feedback form](#), by email to govdocs@glenshiredevonshire.com, or by calling the office at 530.587.6202. Hard copies may also be requested by contacting the office. A Pre-Ballot Election Notice will be posted.

5/15/23 6pm: First Member Comment Forum – A member forum will be hosted where members and the Board can openly discuss the proposed changes. This is an opportunity to have your voice heard in person (or online), and discuss any questions regarding the proposed documents.

6/3/23 10am: Second Member Comment Forum – As we reach the end of the member review period, a final member comment forum will be held.

6/7/23: Member Comments Due –The Board and Governing Documents Committee will compile membership comments, and make any advisable revisions to the documents. Any substantial changes will be reviewed by our Attorney.

6/21/23: Final Board Approval of Draft to Put out for Vote – Board will review and vote to prepare a final version of the Proposed Governing Documents for membership vote.

6/30/2023: Final Proposed Documents – Will be posted to the website and distributed electronically. As always, members may request a hard copy if preferred. Ballots will be mailed to all members.

8/14/23: Deadline for Receipt of Mailed Ballots – pre-paid postage envelopes will be included with the ballots. (*Allow for mailing delays*)

8/17/23: Membership Election Day – Votes will be collected, tallied by 3rd party election officials, and the outcome will be announced at our regular board meeting. (The voting period may be extended if sufficient secret ballots envelopes have not been received.)
