Every year participating sites must submit an annual renewal to maintain their "In Good Standing" status. The above communities are dedicated to maintaining the health of the forest within the associations' common space acreage while minimizing the threat of forest fires. Truckee Fire, Cal Fire and a local certified Forester has assessed and will continue to assess and help manage the fuel reduction and forest health of these parcels. To help offset costs, Truckee Fire and Cal Fire have helped secure over \$100,000 in grants to help fund such projects.

We continue to work with Truckee Fire, Cal Fire, Truckee Police Department as well as other entities to provide fire safety educational outreach. And, upon request, Truckee Fire performs onsite defensible space inspections to help homeowners achieve and maintain a fire safe condition around their homes.
