Take Action Now To Recreate/Live Safely With Lions

At Home

- DO encourage children to play in groups outdoors during daylight hours & with adult supervision
- DO keep pets on-leash & indoors, or in fully-enclosed shelter structures outside
- DO keep barnyard animals in fully-enclosed shelter structures from dusk to dawn
- DO cut back low-lying vegetation 2-3 feet off the ground near buildings that may create hiding spaces
- DO NOT feed wildlife that may attract lions (deer, coyotes, raccoons, feral cats, etc.)

On The Trail

- DO recreate in groups; avoiding venturing into lion habitat during low-light conditions
- DO keep pets on-leash & no more than 6 feet away at all times
- DO wear bright and highly contrasting clothing; bring a whistle, walking stick, or bear spray
- DO NOT approach or feed wildlife - give space and respect
- If encountered: DO NOT run - stay calm. Face the animal, make noise, look bigger. Leave the area.
